**Twenty Seventh Sunday in Ordinary
Time, Year B
Mark 10:2-16**

Jesus' teaching about divorce and remarriage can be a challenging one for many people. The Church continues to uphold the strong and positive teaching of Jesus that God intends for a man and woman to make a lifelong commitment to one another in the Sacrament of Marriage. Many of us, however, know people whose marriage has not been a lifelong commitment. The example of Jesus teaches us that we are called to act with compassion and love in our relationships with all, and especially when people are hurting because of difficulties in their relationships. Most importantly, we remember that when marriages thrive, it is a sign of God's grace at work.

TALK TOGETHER

As you gather as a family, talk about what it means to make a promise or a commitment to someone. Offer examples of promises that are fairly easy to keep. Talk about examples of promises and commitments that might be more difficult to honor, like the marriage commitment that Jesus is asked about in this Gospel. Talk about how we need God to help us honor our commitment to love and care for each other. Jesus teaches that we should be like children before God, trusting God's promise to care for us and asking for his help to keep our commitments to love and care for others.

READ TOGETHER

Read together today's Gospel, Mark 10:2-16.

PRAY TOGETHER

Conclude by praying together that God will give his grace to us that we may honor our commitments to one another. Pray together Saint Ignatius of Loyola's prayer, the Suscipe.

**Vigésimo Séptimo Domingo en el Tiempo

Marcos 10:2-16**

La enseñanza de Jesús sobre el divorcio y el nuevo matrimonio puede ser un desafío para muchas personas. La Iglesia sigue defendiendo la enseñanza firme y positiva de Jesús de que Dios quiere que un hombre y una mujer se comprometan mutuamente para toda la vida en el sacramento del matrimonio. Sin embargo, muchos de nosotros conocemos a personas cuyo matrimonio no ha sido un compromiso de por vida. El ejemplo de Jesús nos enseña que estamos llamados a actuar con compasión y amor en nuestras relaciones con todos, y especialmente cuando las personas están sufriendo debido a dificultades en sus relaciones. Lo más importante es que recordemos que cuando los matrimonios prosperan, es una señal de la gracia de Dios en acción.

HABLEN JUNTOS

Cuando se reúnan como familia, hablen sobre lo que significa hacer una promesa o un compromiso con alguien. Ofrezcan ejemplos de promesas que sean bastante fáciles de cumplir. Hablen sobre ejemplos de promesas y compromisos que podrían ser más difíciles de cumplir, como el compromiso matrimonial sobre el que se le pregunta a Jesús en este Evangelio. Hablen sobre cómo necesitamos que Dios nos ayude a cumplir nuestro compromiso de amarnos y cuidarnos unos a otros. Jesús enseña que debemos ser como hijos ante Dios, confiando en la promesa de Dios de cuidarnos y pidiendo su ayuda para cumplir nuestros compromisos de amar y cuidar a los demás.

LEER JUNTOS

Lean juntos en voz alta el Evangelio de Marcos 10:2-16.

OREN JUNTOS

Concluyamos rezando juntos para que Dios nos conceda su gracia para que podamos honrar nuestros compromisos mutuos. Recen juntos la oración de San Ignacio de Loyola, el Suscipe.

"So out of the ground the Lord God formed every beast of the field and every bird of the air, and brought them to the man to see what he would call them; and whatever the man called every living creature, that was its name." (GENESIS 2:19)

The creation story reminds us of two important points. First, since the start, God has put the entire world into our care. Second, stewardship has been around since the beginning of mankind, it isn't something recently invented by the Church. Just as past generations built our Church, it is now our responsibility to continue to nurture and develop these gifts for future generations.

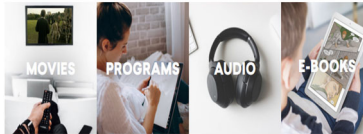

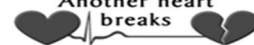

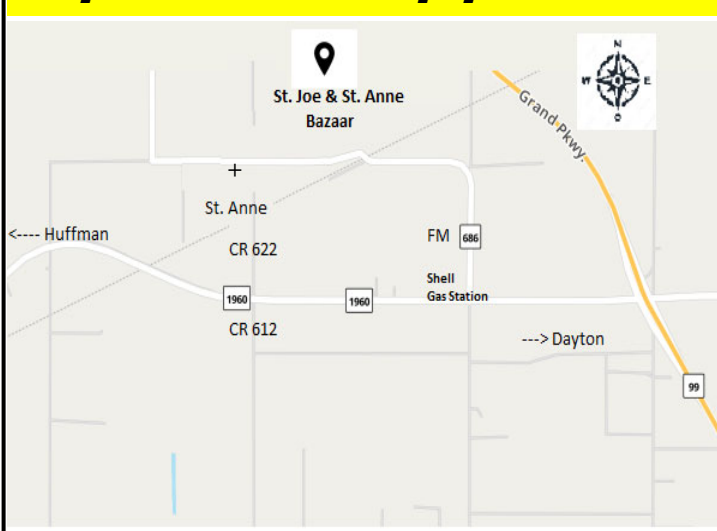
