Pastor's Family Corner

Decimoctavo Domingo en el Tiempo Ordinario
Año C
Lucas 12:13-21

La vida familiar nos ayuda a aprender sobre los valores de la solidaridad y el bien común. Como familia, nos esforzamos por respetar los derechos de cada miembro de la familia y tomar decisiones que promuevan el bien común de la familia.

TALK TOGETHER

Talk about what it would be like if the family ordered a pizza and then divided it unevenly, with some members getting as many pieces as they wanted while others got only a half slice. Talk about how you work to make sure that everyone in the family has his or her fair share. Talk about how your family is also a member of the human family, called to share the goods of creation fairly and justly. Explain that in this Sunday's Gospel, Jesus challenges us to remember that the goods of the world are intended to be shared by all. Talk about the parable of the rich fool and ask family members to describe what they think he did wrong. Emphasize that although the man in the story doesn't seem bad, Jesus points out that this man's flaw was that he was thinking only about himself and his own comfort and security. Emphasize that when we fail to think about the needs of others, we call that a sin of omission. Remind your children that each time we go to Mass, we ask forgiveness for what we have done and for what we have failed to do. We call this prayer the Confiteor.

READ TOGETHER

Read aloud today's Gospel, Luke 12:13-21.

PRAY TOGETHER

Conclude this time together by praying the the Confiteor ("I confess to almighty God...").

HABLEN JUNTOS

Habla sobre cómo sería si la familia pidiera una pizza y luego la dividiera de manera desigual, con algunos miembros obteniendo tantas piezas como querían, mientras que otros solo recibían media rebanada. Comenta sobre cómo trabajas para asegurarte de que todos en la familia tengan su parte justa. Habla sobre cómo tu familia también es parte de la humanidad, llamada a compartir los bienes de la creación de manera justa y equitativa. Explica que en el Evangelio de este domingo, Jesús nos desafía a recordar que los bienes del mundo están destinados a ser compartidos por todos. Comenta sobre la parábola del rico necio y pide a los miembros de la familia que describan lo que creen que hizo mal. Enfatiza que aunque el hombre de la historia no parece malo, Jesús señala que el defecto de este hombre era que solo pensaba en sí mismo y en su propia comodidad y seguridad. Enfatiza que cuando no pensamos en las necesidades de los demás, llamamos a eso un pecado de omisión. Recuerda a tus hijos que cada vez que vamos a Misa, pedimos perdón por lo que hemos hecho y por lo que hemos dejado de hacer. Llamamos a esta oración el Confiteor.

LEAN JUNTOS

Lean juntos el Evangelio de hoy, Lucas 12:13-21.

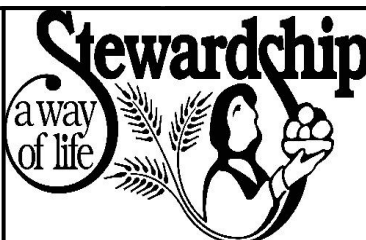
OREN JUNTOS

Concluye este tiempo juntos rezando el Confiteor ("Confieso ante Dios todopoderoso...").

"Take care to guard against all greed, for though one may be rich, one's life does not consist of possessions."

LUKE 12:15

The Gospel message is contrary to modern culture that continually tries to convince us that our joy comes from the material things we possess. That the more we acquire, the happier we will be. Jesus shows us that our true joy comes from our "invisible" gifts like love, mercy, and forgiveness. True joy comes from "emptying" ourselves, giving of ourselves rather than always taking. We are called not to hoard but to share. True joy comes from living a grateful and generous lifestyle; become more "God-centered" and less "self-centered."

La verdadera alegría viene de un estilo de vida agradecido y generoso; de transformarse en más "centrados en Dios" y menos en "nosotros mismos".

Quinceañera

The young lady's family must be registered, participating members of the parish for at least 1 year. "Participating members" are those who faithfully attend Mass and support the Church financially (using their contribution envelopes proving such). Ideally, they should also be active in the ministry, volunteering in the Church.

The young lady must attend CCE classes faithfully for at least 1 YEAR PRIOR to the Quinceañera. She must have received the sacrament of Baptism and she must make her First Holy Communion BEFORE the Quinceañera. She must be faithfully attending Confirmation preparation classes. She, along with her Sponsor, must attend all Quinceañera preparation classes.

Please call office at least 1 YEAR BEFORE any other arrangements are made and DO NOT set a final date for the Quinceañera prior to your interview with the priest.

Quinceañera classes are held TWICE per year.

La familia de la joven debe estar registrada, miembros participantes de la parroquia durante al menos 1 año. Los "miembros participantes" son aquellos que asisten fielmente a la Misa y apoyan económicamente a la Iglesia (utilizando sus sobres de contribución como prueba). Idealmente, también deberían ser activos en el ministerio, como voluntarios en la Iglesia.

La joven debe asistir fielmente a las clases de Catecismo durante al menos 1 AÑO ANTES de la Quinceañera. Ella debe haber recibido el sacramento del Bautismo y debe hacer su Primera Comunión ANTES de la Quinceañera.

Ella debe asistir fielmente a las clases de preparación para la Confirmación. Ella, junto con su Patrocinador, debe asistir las clases de preparación para Quinceañera.

Por favor llame a la oficina al menos 1 AÑO ANTES de que se hagan otros arreglos y NO fije una fecha final para la Quinceañera antes de su entrevista con el sacerdote.

Faith Formation programs exist as an effort to assist parents in passing on the Catholic faith to their children. The guidelines for this diocese state that children must attend classes **EVERY YEAR** beginning in 1st grade. If they do not attend **EVERY YEAR** they will need to attend **AT LEAST ONE YEAR** to learn the basics of the faith **BEFORE** sacrament preparation.

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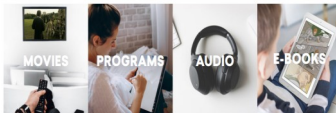

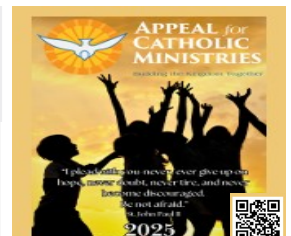
