Nineteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time
Year C
Luke 12:32-48

Years ago, most families had only one or two clocks in their home. Today, we have clocks everywhere—on our walls, on our microwave ovens, on our DVD players, on our cell phones, and so on. As a family, go through the house and count how many clocks (time-telling devices) your family has.

TALK TOGETHER

Talk about important events for which family members need to be on time. Recall experiences of being late for something, either as individuals or as a family. Explain that in this Sunday's Gospel, Jesus talks about how important it is for us to be aware and alert, otherwise, we will miss something. Talk about the parable that Jesus told and discuss how the master will feel if he arrives to find his servant doing his job. Discuss what our job is as disciples of Jesus. Explain that, just as we need to be aware of the time so that we don't miss anything important, we also need to be alert and focused on our jobs, our responsibilities as followers of Jesus. Encourage each family member to place a sacred symbol near the clock that they use most in the house and to use the symbol and the clock as a reminder that it is always "time" for us to be acting like disciples of Christ.

READ TOGETHER

Read aloud today's Gospel, Luke 12:32-48.

PRAY TOGETHER

Conclude this time together by praying Our Father.



Pastor's Family Corner

Decimonoveno Domingo en el Tiempo Ordinario

Lucas 12:32-48

Hace años, la mayoría de las familias solo tenían uno o dos relojes en su hogar. Hoy en día, tenemos relojes en todas partes: en nuestras paredes, en nuestros microondas, en nuestros reproductores de DVD, en nuestros teléfonos celulares, y así sucesivamente. Como familia, recorran la casa y cuenten cuántos relojes (dispositivos que indican la hora) tiene su familia.

HABLEN JUNTOS

Hablen sobre eventos importantes para los cuales los miembros de la familia deben llegar a tiempo. Recuerden experiencias de haber llegado tarde a algo, ya sea como individuos o como familia. Exploren que en el Evangelio de este domingo, Jesús habla sobre lo importante que es para nosotros estar alerta y conscientes, de lo contrario, perderemos algo. Hablen sobre la parábola que Jesús contó y discutan cómo se sentirá el maestro si llega y encuentra a su siervo haciendo su trabajo. Hablen sobre cuál es nuestro trabajo como discípulos de Jesús. Expliquen que, así como necesitamos estar conscientes del tiempo para no perder nada importante, también debemos estar alerta y enfocados en nuestros trabajos, nuestras responsabilidades como seguidores de Jesús. Animen a cada miembro de la familia a colocar un símbolo sagrado cerca del reloj que más usan en la casa y a utilizar el símbolo y el reloj como un recordatorio de que siempre es "tiempo" para que actuemos como discípulos de Cristo.

Lean juntos el Evangelio de hoy, Lucas 12:32-48.

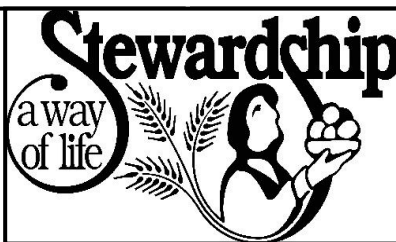
OREN JUNTOS

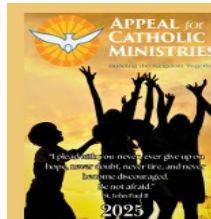

Such devotion is an incentive to a similar love and virtue.

Novena to the Immaculate Heart of Mary:

O Most Blessed Mother, heart of love, heart of mercy, ever listening, caring, consoling, hear our prayer. As your children, we implore your intercession with Jesus your Son. Receive with understanding and compassion the petitions we place before you today, especially ... (special intentions).

Then pray 3 Hail Marys

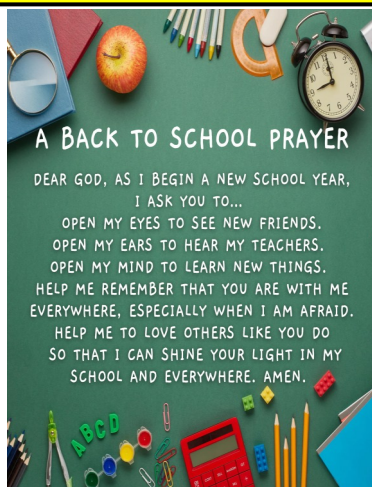
