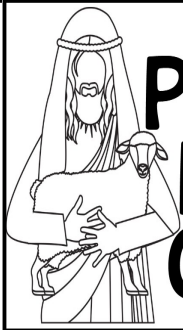

**Twentieth Sunday in Ordinary Time
Year C
Luke 12:49-53**

Families strive for unity and togetherness. Nobody enjoys occasions when divisions in family life become all too evident. Yet, in this Sunday's Gospel, Jesus says that he has come to bring division and that members of households will be divided.



Pastor's Family Corner

**Vigésimo Domingo en el Tiempo Ordinario
Año C
Lucas 12:49-53**

Las familias se esfuerzan por la unidad y la convivencia. A nadie le agradan las ocasiones en que las divisiones en la vida familiar se hacen demasiado evidentes. Sin embargo, en el Evangelio de este domingo, Jesús dice que ha venido a traer división y que los miembros de los hogares estarán divididos.

TALK TOGETHER

Talk as a family about the things that you do together to bring about family unity (togetherness), such as sharing meals, going to church together, celebrating special occasions, or sharing family traditions. Explain that all of these things are important and that Jesus wants families to show this kind of love for one another. Point out that this Sunday's Gospel sounds as though Jesus is saying something very different. Tell your children to listen closely as you read aloud Luke 12:49-53. Explain that sometimes as parents, you have to make decisions that are unpopular with your children. You don't do it to divide the family but because it is the right thing to do. In the short run, such decisions may "divide" children from their parents. In the long run, however, doing the right thing will bring about a deeper unity. Talk to your children about decisions that they have to make that might be unpopular with their friends and how these decisions may divide them from others. Encourage them to pray to the Holy Spirit for the gift of courage (fortitude) so that they may do the right thing even if unpopular.

PRAY TOGETHER

Conclude by praying a spontaneous prayer to the Holy Spirit, asking for the gift of courage (fortitude).

HABLEN JUNTOS

Hablen en familia sobre las cosas que hacen juntos para fomentar la unidad familiar (conjuntos), como compartir comidas, ir a la iglesia juntos, celebrar ocasiones especiales o compartir tradiciones familiares. Explica que todas estas cosas son importantes y que Jesús quiere que las familias muestren este tipo de amor entre sí. Señala que el Evangelio de este domingo suena como si Jesús estuviera diciendo algo muy diferente. Dile a tus hijos que escuchen atentamente mientras lees en voz alta Lucas 12:49-53. Explica que a veces, como padres, tienen que tomar decisiones que no son populares entre sus hijos. No lo haces para dividir a la familia, sino porque es lo correcto. A corto plazo, tales decisiones pueden "dividir" a los niños de sus padres. Sin embargo, a largo plazo, hacer lo correcto traerá una unidad más profunda. Habla con tus hijos sobre decisiones que tienen que tomar y que pueden no ser populares entre sus amigos y cómo estas decisiones pueden separarlos de los demás. Anímalos a orar al Espíritu Santo por el don del coraje (fortaleza) para que puedan hacer lo correcto, incluso si no es popular.

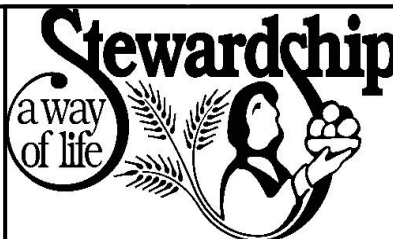
OREN JUNTOS

Concluye orando una oración espontánea al Espíritu Santo, pidiendo el don del coraje (fortaleza).
