Third Sunday In Ordinary, Year A Matthew 4:12-23

Today's Gospel tells us little about the background of these fishermen, their work, and their families. In today's Gospel, we are simply told that James and John left their father, Zebedee, in the boat and followed Jesus. Some details about the families of these first followers of Jesus are found later in Matthew's Gospel, however. In Matthew 8:14-15 for example, Jesus goes to the home of Peter and heals his mother-in-law of a fever. Matthew 20:20-28 relates how the mother of the sons of Zebedee (James and John) approaches Jesus with the request that her sons be given places of honor in Jesus' kingdom. These brief references suggest that the first disciples' separation from their families may not have been as complete as the verses in today's Gospel might lead us to believe. Matthew points out the separation because he wants to show that Christian discipleship can require a change in our lives and even our family relationships. Perhaps the message for us today is to balance the radical call to be a follower of Jesus with the challenge to be "fishers of men" even within our own families. Creating this balance may require that we change some of the priorities of our own family life.

TALK TOGETHER

As a family, detail the activities of a typical day. Discuss together what priorities are reflected in this daily schedule. How does your family respond when your daily plans are interrupted or must be changed? Reflect together on the example of the first disciples who dropped everything to follow Jesus. Ask: Does our family schedule give evidence that we put God first in our family life? What might we do to better reflect that God is our priority?

READ TOGETHER

Read today's Gospel, Matthew 4:12-23.

PRAY TOGETHER

Pray together that your family will always give evidence that God comes first in your family life. Pray today's Psalm or the Lord's Prayer.



Pastor's Family Corner

Tercer Domingo En El Tiempo Ordinario, Año A Mateo 4:12-23

El Evangelio de hoy nos dice poco sobre los antecedentes de estos pescadores, su trabajo y sus familias. En el Evangelio de hoy, simplemente se nos dice que Santiago y Juan dejaron a su padre,

Zebedeo, en la barca y siguieron a Jesús. Sin embargo, algunos detalles sobre las familias de estos primeros seguidores de Jesús se encuentran más adelante en el Evangelio de Mateo. Por ejemplo, en Mateo 8:14-15, Jesús va a la casa de Pedro y sana a su suegra de una fiebre. Mateo 20:20-28 relata cómo la madre de los hijos de Zebedeo (Santiago y Juan) se acerca a Jesús con la petición de que se les concedan a sus hijos lugares de honor en el reino de Jesús. Estas breves referencias sugieren que la separación de los primeros discípulos de sus familias puede no haber sido tan completa como los versículos del Evangelio de hoy podrían hacernos creer. Mateo señala la separación porque quiere mostrar que el discipulado cristiano puede requerir un cambio en nuestras vidas e incluso en nuestras relaciones familiares. Tal vez el mensaje para nosotros hoy sea equilibrar el llamado radical a ser seguidores de Jesús con el desafío de ser "pescadores de hombres" incluso dentro de nuestras propias familias. Crear este equilibrio puede requerir que cambiemos algunas de las prioridades de nuestra vida familiar.

LEER JUNTOS

Como familia, detallen las actividades de un día típico. Discutan juntos qué prioridades se reflejan en este horario diario. ¿Cómo responde su familia cuando sus planes diarios se interrumpen o deben ser cambiados? Reflexionen juntos sobre el ejemplo de los primeros discípulos que lo dejaron todo para seguir a Jesús. Pregunten: ¿Nuestro horario familiar da evidencia de que ponemos a Dios primero en nuestra vida familiar? ¿Qué podríamos hacer para reflejar mejor que Dios es nuestra prioridad?

LEER JUNTOS

Lean juntos el Evangelio de hoy, Mateo 4:12-23.

OREN JUNTOSO

Recen juntos para que su familia siempre dé testimonio de que Dios ocupa el primer lugar en la vida familiar. Recen el Salmo de hoy o el Padre Nuestro.

"He called them, and immediately they left their boat and their father and followed Him."

MATTHEW 4:22

Just as Jesus called the first apostles, He calls each of us to follow Him, too. Not everyone is called to leave their business or family behind, but we are expected to put God first in everything. In gratitude to God, we should give our first and best of everything to Him: our time in daily prayer, our talent in participating in one of our parish ministries and our treasure to support the financial needs of our parish mission.

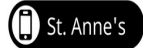

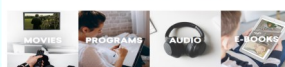

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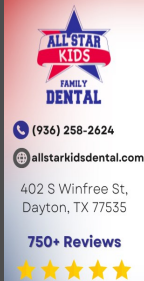
