The Baptism of the Lord, Year A Matthew 3:13-17

At Jesus' baptism, God affirms his Son's mission for salvation. God announces his pleasure with Jesus and, in Matthew's Gospel, announces to all that, "This is my beloved Son" (Matthew 3:17). With this affirmation, Jesus is able to resist the temptations described next in Matthew's Gospel and to begin his public ministry. As family members, we can support one another in our Christian living by affirming the importance of each person in our eyes and in God's. Confident that through our Baptism we too were made children of God, we can resist temptation and share in Christ's mission.

TALK TOGETHER

Recall that God's message about Jesus was meant for us, "This is my beloved Son." It was also an affirmation for Jesus about his role in God's plan. Place each family member's name on a slip of paper and put the names in a bowl. Invite each person in the family to choose another family member's name and to prepare a message for that person, affirming their importance in God's eyes and in your family life. Pray together that your family will continue to support one another in your baptismal promises to be disciples of Jesus and then invite each person to read aloud the message they prepared.

READ TOGETHER

Read today's Gospel, Matthew 3:13-17.

PRAY TOGETHER

Conclude by praying together the Lord's Prayer.



Pastor's Family Corner

El Bautismo del Señor, Año A Mateo 3:13-17

En el bautismo de Jesús, Dios afirma la misión de su Hijo para la salvación. Dios expresa su agrado por Jesús y, en el Evangelio de Mateo, anuncia a todos que, "Este es mi Hijo amado" (Mateo 3:17).

Con esta afirmación, Jesús puede resistir las tentaciones que se describen a continuación en el Evangelio de Mateo y comenzar su ministerio público. Como miembros de la familia, podemos apoyarnos mutuamente en nuestra vida cristiana afirmando la importancia de cada persona a nuestros ojos y a los de Dios. Confiados en que a través de nuestro Bautismo también fuimos hechos hijos de Dios, podemos resistir la tentación y participar en la misión de Cristo.

LEER JUNTOS

Recuerda que el mensaje de Dios sobre Jesús estaba destinado para nosotros: "Este es mi Hijo amado." También fue una afirmación para Jesús sobre su papel en el plan de Dios. Escribe el nombre de cada miembro de la familia en un trozo de papel y pon los nombres en un tazón. Invita a cada persona de la familia a escoger el nombre de otro miembro y a preparar un mensaje para esa persona, afirmando su importancia ante los ojos de Dios y en la vida familiar. Recen juntos para que su familia continúe apoyándose mutuamente en las promesas bautismales de ser discípulos de Jesús, y luego invita a cada persona a leer en voz alta el mensaje que preparó.

LEER JUNTOS

Lean juntos el Evangelio de hoy, Mateo 3:13-17.

OREN JUNTOS

Concluyamos rezando juntos El Padre Nuestro.

"John tried to prevent him, saying, 'I need to be baptized by you, yet you are coming to me?'" MATTHEW 3:14

The Catholic Catechism states that "Jesus' immersion in the water is a sign for all human beings of the need to die to themselves to do God's will." In other words, as baptized Catholics there is only one gift that we need to give to Jesus – the gift of ourselves. Surrender yourself to God, place your trust in Him and allow the Holy Spirit to work through you for the greater glory of God.

Baptism Of the Lord



Bautismo Del Señor

Today the Church celebrates the Feast of the Baptism of Our Lord. This brings to an end the season of Christmas. The Church recalls Our Lord's second manifestation or epiphany which occurred on the occasion of His baptism in the Jordan. Jesus descended into the River to sanctify its waters and to give them the power to beget sons of God. The event takes on the importance of a second creation in which the entire Trinity intervenes. In the Eastern Church this feast is called Theophany because at the baptism of Christ in the River Jordan God appeared in three persons. The baptism of John was a sort of sacramental preparatory for the Baptism of Christ. It moved men to sentiments of repentance and induced them to confess their sins. Christ did not need the baptism of John. Although He appeared in the "substance of our flesh" and was recognized "outwardly like unto ourselves," He was absolutely sinless and impeccable. He conferred upon the water the power of the true Baptism which would remove all the sins of the world: "Behold the Lamb of God, behold Him Who takes away the sin of the world." Many of the incidents which accompanied Christ's baptism are symbolical of what happened at our Baptism. At Christ's baptism the Holy Spirit descended upon Him; at our Baptism the Trinity took its abode in our soul. At His baptism Christ was proclaimed the "Beloved Son" of the Father; at our Baptism we become the adopted sons of God. At Christ's baptism the heavens were opened; at our Baptism heaven was opened to us. At His baptism Jesus prayed; after our Baptism we must pray to avoid actual sin.

Hoy la Iglesia celebra la fiesta del Bautismo de Nuestro Señor, con la que concluye el tiempo de Navidad. La Iglesia recuerda la segunda manifestación o epifanía de Nuestro Señor, que tuvo lugar con ocasión de su bautismo en el Jordán. Jesús descendió al río para santificar sus aguas y darles el poder de engendrar hijos de Dios. El acontecimiento adquiere la importancia de una segunda creación en la que interviene toda la Trinidad. En la Iglesia oriental esta fiesta se llama Teofanía porque en el bautismo de Cristo en el río Jordán Dios se apareció en tres personas. El bautismo de Juan era una especie de preparación sacramental para el bautismo de Cristo. Movía a los hombres a sentimientos de arrepentimiento y los inducía a confesar sus pecados. Cristo no necesitaba el bautismo de Juan. Aunque se apareció en la "sustancia de nuestra carne" y fue reconocido "exteriormente como nosotros", era absolutamente sin pecado e impecable. Él confirió al agua el poder del verdadero Bautismo que quitaría todos los pecados del mundo: "He aquí el Cordero de Dios, he aquí a Aquel que quita el pecado del mundo". Muchos de los incidentes que acompañaron el bautismo de Cristo son simbólicos de lo que sucedió en nuestro Bautismo. En el bautismo de Cristo, el Espíritu Santo descendió sobre Él; en nuestro Bautismo, la Trinidad tomó su morada en nuestra alma. En Su bautismo, Cristo fue proclamado "Hijo Amado" del Padre; en nuestro Bautismo nos convertimos en hijos adoptivos de Dios. En el bautismo de Cristo, los cielos se abrieron; en nuestro Bautismo, el cielo se abrió para nosotros. En Su bautismo, Jesús oró; después de nuestro Bautismo, debemos orar para evitar el pecado actual.
