Second Sunday In Ordinary, Year A John 1:29-34

The ministry of John the Baptist prepared for and pointed to the ministry of Jesus. In a similar way, our lives are to offer testimony to who we know Jesus to be for us and for the world. Jesus is the Lamb of God who takes away the sins of the world. How does the witness of our lives give testimony to the reconciling presence of Christ?

TALK TOGETHER

As a family, identify as many titles for Jesus as possible, such as Lamb of God, Son of God, Prince of Peace, and so on. Talk together about what these different titles mean and what they tell you about Jesus. Consider how John the Baptist gives testimony to who Jesus is. Talk about what people might come to know about Jesus by observing your family life.

READ TOGETHER

Read today's Gospel, John 1:29-34.

PRAY TOGETHER

Pray together that your family life will show others that Jesus is the Son of God, the lamb who takes away the sins of the world. Pray the Lord's Prayer.

LEER JUNTOS

Como familia, identifiquen tantos títulos para Jesús como sea posible, como Cordero de Dios, Hijo de Dios, Príncipe de Paz, y así sucesivamente. Hablen juntos sobre lo que significan estos diferentes títulos y lo que les dicen sobre Jesús. Consideren cómo Juan el Bautista da testimonio de quién es Jesús. Hablen sobre lo que la gente podría llegar a conocer acerca de Jesús al observar la vida de su familia.

LEER JUNTOS

Lean juntos el Evangelio de hoy, Juan 1:29-34.

OREN JUNTOS

Oren juntos para que la vida de su familia muestre a los demás que Jesús es el Hijo de Dios, el cordero que quita los pecados del mundo. Recen el Padre Nuestro.

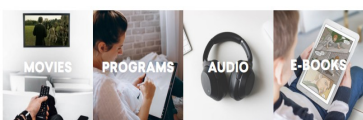

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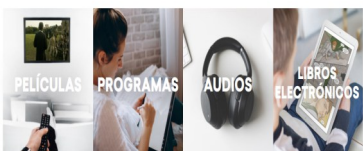

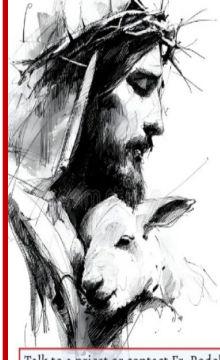
