

Twenty Third Sunday in Ordinary Time, Year B
Mark 7:31-37

Today's Gospel invites us to consider how we witness the healing presence of Christ in our care for and ministry to those who are sick. We notice that the deaf man is brought to Jesus for healing by his friends. These people beg Jesus to lay his hands on this deaf man so that he might be healed. Jesus' healing power is shown in his opening of the man's ears and the restoring of his speech. When family members care for one another when they are sick, they bring Christ's healing presence. When we pray for those who are ill, we ask God to show his healing power. When health is restored, we share that good news with others.

TALK TOGETHER

As you gather as a family, recall a time when a family member was ill. What steps were taken to help restore this family member to health? Talk about what it feels like to care for a person who is ill, and about how it feels to be the sick person being cared for. In today's Gospel, we hear about a time when Jesus healed a man who was deaf. Notice how the man who was cured and his friends could not honor Jesus' request to keep quiet about Jesus' power to heal. We continue to celebrate Jesus' healing presence in our lives by giving thanks to God for the gift of healing and health.

READ TOGETHER

Read today's Gospel, Mark 7:31-37.

PRAY TOGETHER

Conclude in prayer, thanking Jesus for the gifts of health and healing. Pray together for those who are sick. After each person is named, pray, "Jesus, heal us."

"Did not God choose those who are poor in the world to be rich in faith and heirs of the kingdom that he promised to those who love him?" JAMES 2:5

What is more important - being rich in faith or rich in possessions? Society tells us that possessions are most important. God teaches a different lesson. When we are rich in faith, we keep God first and experience true joy and peace. When we put possessions first, we soon realize we can never have enough and happiness is fleeting. When we put faith over possessions we truly realize it is better to give than receive.

Vigésimo Tercero Domingo en el Tiempo Ordinario, Año B
Marcos 7:31-37

El Evangelio de hoy nos invita a considerar cómo damos testimonio de la presencia sanadora de Cristo en nuestro cuidado y ministerio hacia los enfermos. Observamos que los amigos del hombre sordo lo llevan a Jesús para que lo sane.

Estas personas le ruegan a Jesús que imponga sus manos sobre este hombre sordo para que pueda sanar. El poder sanador de Jesús se muestra al abrirle los oídos al hombre y restaurarle el habla. Cuando los miembros de una familia se cuidan unos a otros cuando están enfermos, llevan la presencia sanadora de Cristo. Cuando oramos por los enfermos, le pedimos a Dios que muestre su poder sanador. Cuando se recupera la salud, compartimos esa buena noticia con los demás.

HABLEN JUNTOS

Cuando se reúnan en familia, recuerden una ocasión en la que un miembro de la familia estuvo enfermo. ¿Qué medidas se tomaron para ayudar a que este miembro de la familia recuperara la salud? Hablen sobre cómo se siente cuidar a una persona enferma y cómo se siente ser la persona enferma a la que se cuida. En el Evangelio de hoy, escuchamos sobre una ocasión en la que Jesús sanó a un hombre sordo. Observen cómo el hombre que fue curado y sus amigos no pudieron cumplir con el pedido de Jesús de guardar silencio sobre el poder de Jesús para sanar. Seguimos celebrando la presencia sanadora de Jesús en nuestras vidas dando gracias a Dios por el don de la sanación y la salud.

LEER JUNTOS

Lean juntos en voz alta el Evangelio de Marcos 7:31-37.

OREN JUNTOS

Concluyan con una oración, agradeciendo a Jesús por los dones de la salud y la sanación. Oremos juntos por los enfermos. Después de nombrar a cada persona, oren: "Jesús, cúranos".



The Exaltation of the Cross

The Exaltation of the Holy Cross is commemorated by the Holy Catholic Church on September 14th and is a reminder of the importance of the core symbol of our faith as well as the sacrifice that Our Lord made upon the Holy Cross for our salvation. We honor that Cross on which Christ won for us our redemption. The Cross is the universal symbol of Christianity, and is a sign of victory over something that once was synonymous with a method of brutal torture. The Cross represents hope, salvation, freedom, and unconditional love. Our Lord loved us all so much, He chose to suffer a violent death on the Cross to save us all from the shackles of sin.
